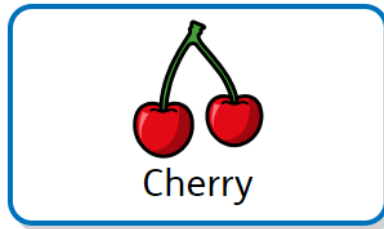

### Weekly news from Cherry Class



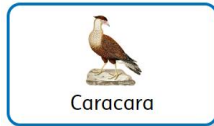
